2020 BEGINNERS: We have already had a few enquiries for potential new members for next year. We will accept beginners from our first Tuesday night in February (18th).

Tuesday evening consists of Basics and Mainstream alternating brackets. The Basic Brackets cater for beginners at any level. The Mainstream brackets cater for dancers who have attended the previous 12 months of Basic "lessons" and emphasis is on moves not completed or missed in the previous 12 months. These sessions help prepare dancers for "full" mainstream dancing that is the accepted level for festivals and conventions. This is also an opportunity for ladies to learn and practice dancing in the "left hand" position.

A special bonus is offered to those financial members who attend Saturday club nights and come to support and assist on Tuesdays. You will be given, **on request**, a free pass for Tuesday nights when you pay your admission on Saturday but – **DON'T FORGET TO ASK.**

The year began with few changes to our committee and my sincere gratitude to those who volunteer their time to serve our club to ensure our future. Without this dedication the rumours could certainly turn into reality. Our new President Carol is ever present at club activities and encourages members to support her and our club.
